



Peru Scholars Program at St. Mary's University

St. Mary's University in San Antonio, Texas, is offering exceptional students from the four Marianist high schools in Peru the opportunity to continue their Marianist education at a respected university that fosters academic excellence in the Catholic and Marianist traditions.

There are three levels of grants: "Full ride" grants to two students from any of the four Marianist high schools in Peru which will pay full tuition, fees, room and board charges, one full-tuition grant (approximately \$30,000 per year) and two half-tuition grants will be available for up to four years per award, dependent on maintaining at least a 3.0 GPA.

Apply to the Peruvian Scholars Program

- Submit an essay that addresses how this program and attending St. Mary's University will affect your future. How do you expect to contribute to your community in the future? Use these questions as a guide:
 1. Who are you? Tell us your story.
 2. What has shaped and continues to shape your character?
 3. What role does faith play in your life?
 4. How have you built community in your school, neighborhood, parish or nonprofit?
 5. How do you understand leadership, and in what ways have you demonstrated leadership?

- Complete the online admission application to St. Mary's University and submit all required documentation. Find it at www.stmarytx.edu/apply.

Academic standing, commitment to service and leadership, letters of recommendation, and economic need will be taken into consideration. Students do not need to take the SAT to qualify for financial assistance. Students not selected for these grants could still be considered for other support opportunities based on academic records alone.

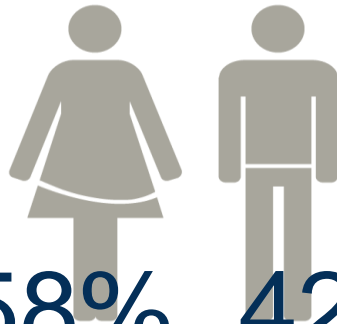

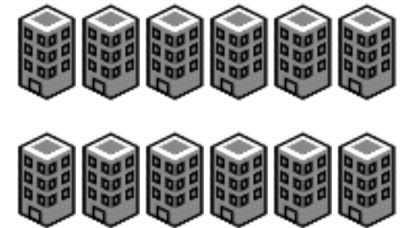

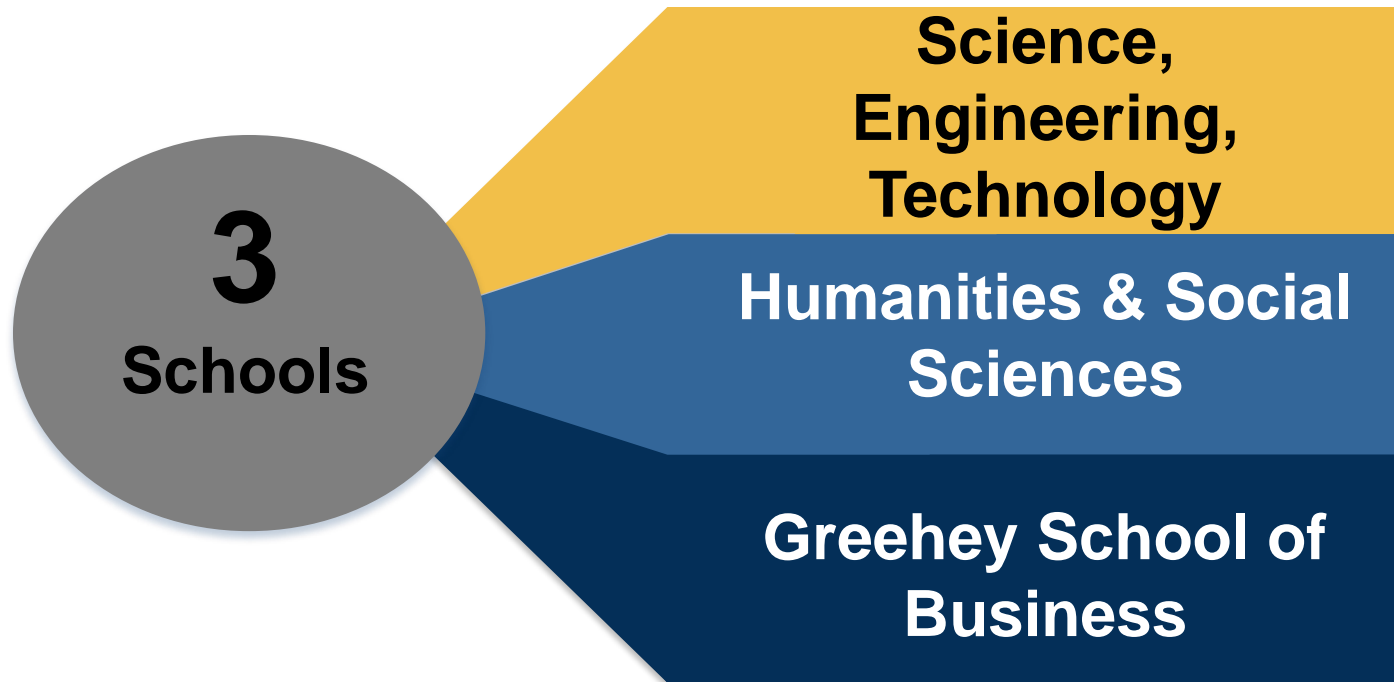

- Submit application for admission on St. Mary's website: www.stmarytx.edu/apply
- Submit transcript from school.
- Submit IELTS or TOEFL exam scores for English proficiency.
- Submit essay as described in requirements.

- One (1) Full Tuition Scholarship.
- Two (2) Half-Tuition Scholarships.
- Entry in the Fall of 2017 semester or Spring 2018 Semester.
